



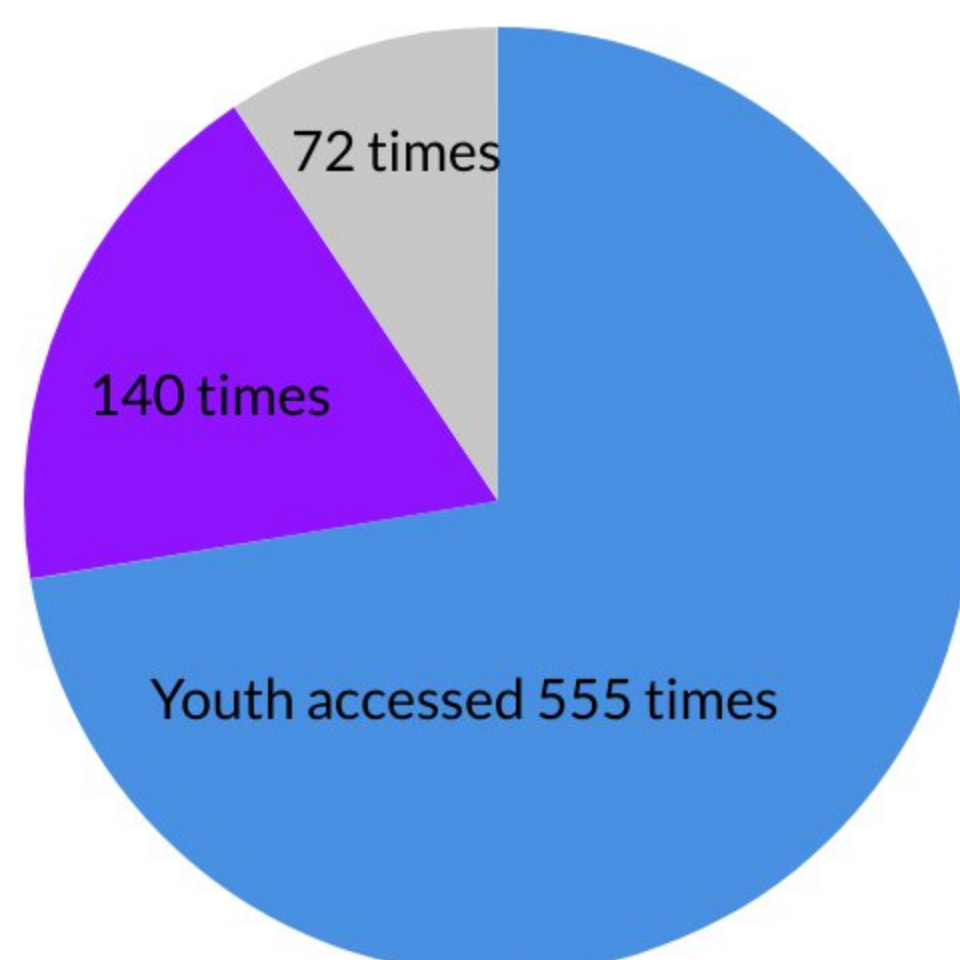
Safe Spaces Annual Report 2019

What is Safe Spaces?

Safe Spaces is a program for youth ages 12-26 who identify as Two-Spirit, Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, or Questioning, and their allies. Youth-driven, drop-in groups meet weekly with one to one support services offered as needed.

Safe Spaces also provides workshops and presentations on Gender and Sexual Orientation in Kamloops and surrounding communities.

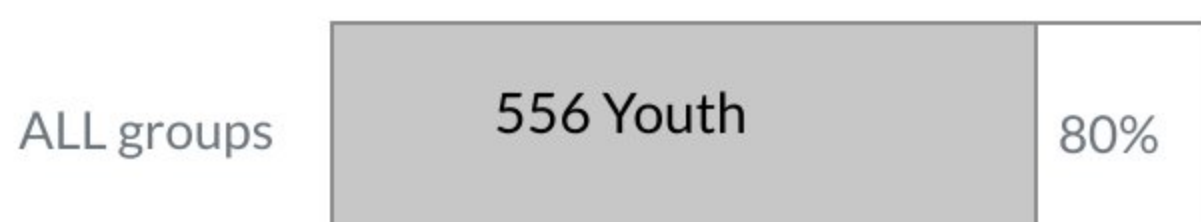

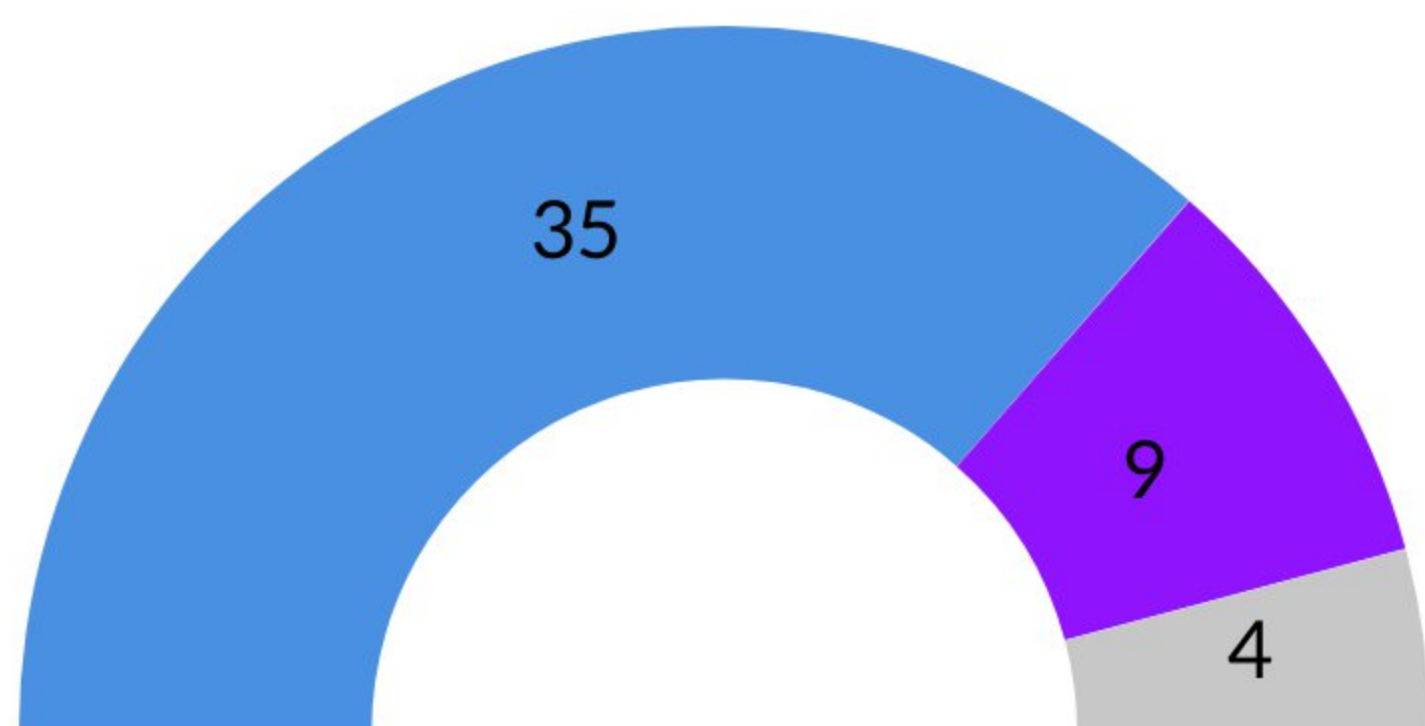
