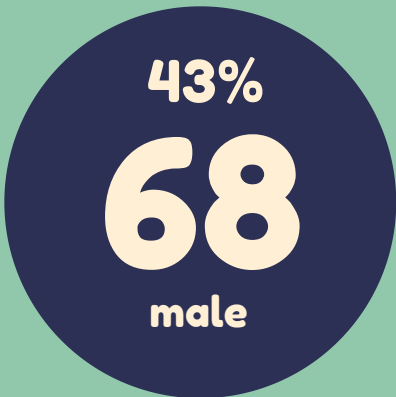
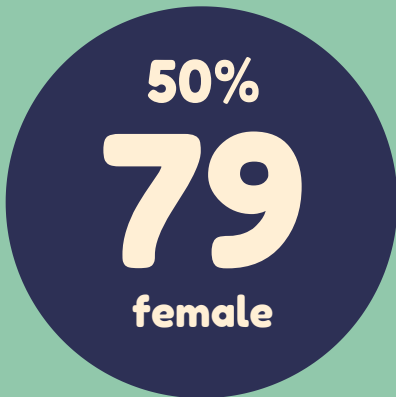

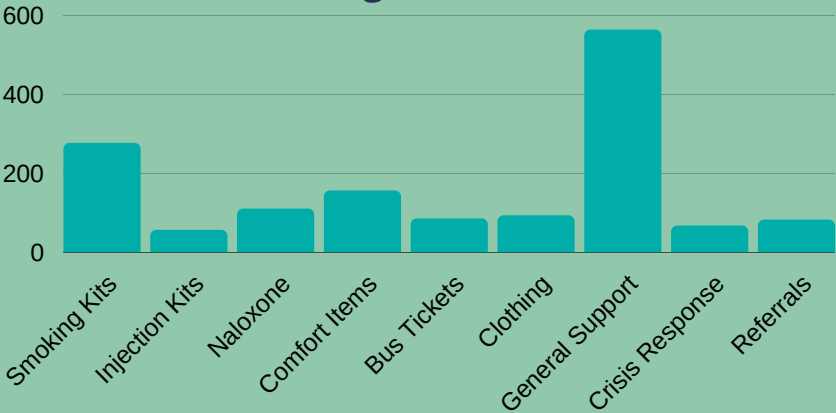

Mental Health and Addiction Concerns

- 39 youth reported experiencing anxiety
- 42 youth reported experiencing depression
- 39 youth reported experiencing trauma
- 14 youth reported consuming alcohol
- 45 youth reported using substances
- 40 youth accessed Harm Reduction services
- 11 youth reported experiencing an overdose
- 7 youth reported accessing detox/treatment
- 0 youth experienced a fatal overdose
