

In Office Counselling Program 2023

INOC program participant stats

Our program has served and supported 250 clients in 2023.

78% of those clients were first time clients to our counselling program.

22% of those clients were clients who had accessed our program in the past and were returning.

81% of the clients who were supported in our program identified as Caucasian.

5%- of clients who were supported in our program identified as Indigenous

The majority age of clients supported in our program were between the ages of 30-39.

With an increase the number of clients aged 60 and over.

INOC program length of service stats

90% of clients completed the program in 3 - 4 month

In 2023, the average wait time for counselling services from the time the request of service was made to being offered services was 30 days.

INOC referrals

55% are referred by MCFD

45% are self-referred

INOC goal type

49% wanted to increase their own emotional well-being

26% wanted to contribute to wellness inside family relationships

25% wanted to decease their choice of violence and increase safety to those inside their family system.

INOC program Trends

In 2023 we saw an increase of the number of referrals indicating support for grandparents raising their grandkids and grandparents whom are co-parenting with the primary parent (s).

In 2023, we documented a decrease in how many clients moved in the past year. More clients indicated living in the same home for over a year or more.

Most common presenting problem

Violence inside the family system

Substance use of one or more of the primary parents.
